HUMANITARIAN ENDEAVOR

Last July, **Spencer Romo '07** and his mother, **Terry Romo R.N.**, took part in the SAGE/HELP's mission, a local program which provides medical care and community development to the people of rural Guatemala. During their week-long initiative, Spencer and Mrs. Romo, along with other volunteers, treated 1,300 patients, performed 85 surgeries, extracted decayed teeth from 120 patients; fitted many with glasses and provided care that they would have otherwise never received.
