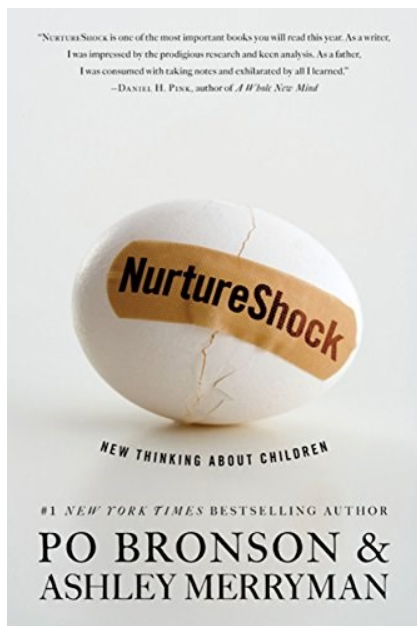


Nurture Shock
